

Life Group Notes: 'Prayer - The Power of Relationship' Tuesday 4th June 2019

READ THESE VERSES TOGETHER:

PSALM 145:18:

The Lord is near to all who call on him, to all who call on him in truth.

JEREMIAH 33:3:

Call to me and I will answer you and will tell you great and hidden things that you have not known.

JAMES 4:8a:

Draw near to God and he will draw near to you

HEBREWS 4:16:

Let us then with confidence draw near to the throne of grace, that we may receive mercy and find grace to help in time of need.

INTRODUCTION:

God's desire has always been to draw close to us and allow him to be part of our lives. God is attracted to hunger for him and vulnerability. When we choose to draw near, he promises he will draw near to us.

So, what does it mean to draw near to God? It means spending time with him in praise and worship. God is very attracted to a heart full of gratitude and thankfulness. Psalm 75:1 says: "We give thanks to you, O God; for your name is near. We recount your wondrous deeds.". It also means talking to him and learning to keep talking to him all throughout the day, "praying at all times in the Spirit, with all prayer and supplication." Ephesians 6:18. Another important key is reading the Bible. "You will know the truth, and the truth will set you free." John 8:32.

Drawing near to God is not about our feelings or emotions, which can change all the time. It is about making a conscious decision to invite him to be part of our lives, no matter what the circumstances are. It is about being aware that our deepest needs, our deepest desires, our deepest fulfilment, are only found in Jesus. It is knowing that we need Holy Spirit to help us, guide us, convict us, teach us and give us fresh understanding of his love for us on a continual basis. It is taking time to listen to him, allowing him to speak to us and responding to his direction.

God is attracted to hunger for him! He desires to have an intimate relationship with every one of us. It is our responsibility as individuals to cultivate and develop that relationship with him. "Draw near to God and he will draw near to you," James 4:8.

ACTION POINTS & PRAYER:

This year in Life Groups we will be focusing more attention on prayer. The Bible instructs us to 'pray without ceasing' (1 Thessalonians 5:17). Prayer is the engine room of the church and without prayer, we will not see God do significant things through us personally, through the corporate church and in our city and nations.

Marriage Course:

The Marriage Course started in May – pray that marriages, relationships and families will be strengthened as people learn more about marriage with Jesus at the centre. Outreach:
